The Orders will come into force on 18 March 2024. The effect of the Orders will be to introduce the following: -

(d) on the east side of Como Road, install a cycle hanger outside Nos. 69/71 Como Road. PTO 1038 - The effect of these proposals will be to introduce various no waiting 'at any time' 3

restrictions and revoke existing restrictions to facilitate the introduction of new bus stop

clearways (BSC) for the 'Hail and Ride' conversion for Route 336 bus programme. (a) Canadian Avenue - on the east side, remove 22.2m residents parking and 1.8m of single yellow line restriction outside 1 to 24 Maple.

(b) Fordmill Road - introduce i) 5m of no waiting at any time on the south-east side, outside No.48a

Canadian Avenue; ii), 5m of no waiting 'at any time' on the west side opposite No.19 Fordmill Road; iii), 5m of no waiting 'at any time' on the east side adjacent to No.59 Fordmill Road. Brookhowse Road - introduce no waiting 'at any time' on the west side 7.5m outside No.82 and (c) 5.9m outside No.88 Brookhowse Road.

Whitefoot Lane -, introduce 3m of no waiting 'at any time' on the south side either side of the (d) bus stop clearway outside 1 to 54 Forster House.

Plough Way -, introduce 32.5m of no waiting 'at any time' on the north side opposite Grove Street.

(e) (f) Downderry Road - on the east side, remove 24.4m of no waiting 'at any time' opposite

Nos.93/95/97/99 Downderry Road.

Churchdown -, i) remove 5m of no waiting 'at any time' on the south side adjacent to No.107; (g) ii) introduce 3m of no waiting 'at any time' on the north side outside No.96; iii) introduce 3m of

no waiting 'at any time' on the south-west side either side of the bus stop clearway outside

No.11 and No.19;, introduce 19m of no waiting 'at any time' on the west side adjacent to the Community Mental Health Centre.

(h) Torridon Road -, extend the no waiting 'at any time' by 10m on the east side outside the

Community Library. Haddington Road -introduce 5m of no waiting 'at any time' on the east side, either side of the (i) bus stop clearway, opposite Nos.19/21/23.

- Oakshade Road –remove 4.35m of no waiting 'at any time' on the north side, adjacent to No. 91 (i) Downderry Road and introduce 5m of no waiting 'at any time' west of new BSC
- Shroffold Road/Ravenscar Road introduce 10m of no waiting 'at any time' on the southeast (k) junction of Shroffold Road and Ravenscar Road and 3m on the east side of Shroffold Road
- opposite No.23.
- PTO 1039 in the vicinity of No 1-20 Eastdown Park remove 14 metres of resident parking on
- southeast side replacing with no waiting at any time and relocate on the northwest side a length of 12 metres as part of a shared use loading only (7am - 11am maximum stay 40 minutes) with resident parking (11am - 6.30pm) Monday to Saturday.
- PTO 1041 The effect of these proposals will be to introduce a cycle hangar in Harvard Road, 5. opposite No.62/64, and will be 2.5m in length, which will replace a length of permit holders parking.
