NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM

- 1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting (i) Glenbow Road, between Bromley Hill and a point 25 metres northeastwards; (ii) Sandpit Road, between Bromley Hill and a point 25 metres northeastwards; and (iii) Flimwell Close, between Bromley Hill and a point 10 metres northeastwards. (2) The respective diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibitions are via (i) Glenbow Road, Farmfield Road, Bromley Road and Bromley Hill, and vice versa; (ii) Sandpit Road, Farmfield Road and Bromley Road, and vice versa; and (iii) Bromley Hill.
- Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
 The Order comes into force on the 1st April 2024 to remain in force
- for up to 4 months. (Note: Works are planned to be completed in phases with an overall completion date in June, but additional duration is given for contingencies).
