## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A23 GLA ROAD (BRIXTON HILL, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2024

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water mains maintenance and refurbishment works to take place on the A23 Brixton Hill.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning left into Acre Lane from Brixton Hill.

The Order will be effective from 8:00 AM on 5th April 2024 until 6:00 PM on 7th April 2024, or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
     anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police.
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs for vehicles via Brixton Hill, Brixton Road, Stockwell Road, Clapham Road, Clapham High Street, Clapham Park Road and Acre Lane to normal route of travel. For pedal cycles via Brixton Road, Brighton Terrace and Trinity Gardens to normal route of travel.
