ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A232 GLA ROAD (DUPPAS HILL ROAD, STAFFORD ROAD AND SIDE ROADS, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Croydon hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable drainage inspection works to take place on the A232 Duppas Hill Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) stopping on Stafford Road between its junctions with Epsom Road and Purley Way;
 - (2) stopping at the eastern kerb-line of Glen Gardens between its junction with Duppas Hill Road and the extended northern property boundary of line of Taormina, No. 7, Duppas Hill Road;
 - (3) stopping at the north-eastern kerb-line of Duppas Road between a point 12.5 metres south-east of the extended north-western building line of Westmount, No. 1, Duppas Hill Road and its junction with Duppas Hill Road;
 - (4) stopping on Duppas Hill Road between the extended common boundary of Fairview, No. 13 Duppas Hill Road and The Cottage, No 12 Duppas Hill Road and its junction with Glen Gardens;
 - (5) entering, exiting or proceeding on Warrington Road between the extended southern building line of No. 1 to 18 Ludford Close and its junction with Duppas Hill Road.

The Order will also allow all vehicles to use the southbound bus lane on Stafford Road between the extended common boundary of Nos. 15 and 17 Stafford Road and the extended common boundary of Nos. 75 and 77 Stafford Road.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 18th March 2024 and 23rd September 2024 each night 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Harrison's Rise, Epsom Road and Duppas Road to normal route of travel.
