## **Transport for London Notice**

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A210 GLA ROAD (ELTHAM ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable mains water connection works to take place at the A210 Etham Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from;
  - stopping at the eastern kerb-line of the A2213 Kidbrooke Park Road between its junction with the A210 Eltham Road and a point 145 meters northwards;
  - (2) proceeding in an easterly direction on the A210 Eltham Road between its junctions with the A2213 Kidbrooke Park Road and the dedicated left turn road connecting the westbound carriageway of the A210 Eltham Road with the south-eastbound carriageway of the A20 Sidcup Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 12:01 AM on the 2nd April 2024 until 7:00 PM on the 14th April 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the traffic prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Sidcup Road, Westhorne Avenue, Eltham Road to normal route of travel.
