ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3220 GLA ROAD (LATCHMERE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.The purpose of the Order is to allow bridge inspection works to take place on A3220 Latchmere Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting or proceeding on Latchmere Road between its junctions with Knowsley Road and Sheepcote Lane.
 Local access only will be maintained between Lavender Hill and Knowsley Road and between Battersea Park Road and Sheepcote Lane.
 The Order will be effective from 10:00 PM on 28th March 2024 to 6:00 AM on 29th March 2024 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as
- shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police.
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via: Latchmere Road, Lavender Hill, Falcon Road, Battersea Park Road or reverse to normal route of travel OR via Latchmere Road, Lavender Hill, Queenstown Road, Battersea Park Road or reverse to normal route of travel.
