ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (PURLEY WAY AND SIDE ROADS, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, STOPPING AND BANNED TURN) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Croydon hereby gives notice that it has made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable drainage investigation works to take place on the A23 Purley Way.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) stopping on Russell Green Close between its junctions with Gilliam Grove and A23 Purley Way;
 - (2) stopping on Russell Hill Road between its junctions with Foxley Lane/Pampisford Road and Brighton Road;
 - (3) turning right from Highfield Road onto A23 Purley Way;
 - (4) turning left from Highfield Road onto A23 Purley Road;
 - (5) entering, exiting or proceeding in a south-westerly direction on Pampisford Road between the extended south-eastern building line of No. 16-18 Pampisford Road and its junction with A23 Purley Way.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective between 16th March 2024 and 30th October 2024 each night 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs for traffic wanting to travel in Pampisford Road to A23 Purley Way via Edgehill Road and A23 Purley Way to normal route of travel or via Christchurch Road, A235 Brighton Road, A22/A23 roundabout, A23 Banstead Road and Foxley Lane to normal route of travel. For traffic wanting to turn left onto A23 Purley Way from Highfield Road via Edgehill Road, Pampisford Road and Waddon Way to normal route of travel. For traffic wanting to turn right onto A23 Purley Way from Highfield Road via A23 Purley Way northbound, Waddon Way, Pampisford Road and Edgehill Road to normal route of travel.
