ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A4 GLA ROAD (WEST CROMWELL ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF HAMMERSMITH & FULHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) (NO.2) ORDER 2024

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable mobile crane works to take place on West Cromwell Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting or proceeding eastbound on West Cromwell Road between its junctions with North End Road and Warwick Road.
 The Order will be effective from the 29th March 2024 to 1st July 2024, every Friday at 10:00 PM to Monday at 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. he prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;(2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police.
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Great West Road, Hammersmith Bridge Road, Queen Caroline Street, Hammersmith Road, Kensington High Street, Earls Court Road, West Cromwell Road onto normal route of travel. [For HGVs] North End Road, Lillie Road, Old Brompton Road, Warwick Road onto normal route of travel.
