ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A302 GLA ROAD (WESTMINSTER BRIDGE ROAD AND SIDE ROADS, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH AND LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, STOPPING AND BANNED TURNS) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it has made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable network rail works on Waterloo Railway Station to take place on the A302 Westminster Bridge Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting, or proceeding on the A302 Westminster Bridge Road between its junctions with Addington Street and Station Approach Road;
 - (2) entering, exiting, or proceeding on Upper Marsh between its junctions with the access road to the rear of Nos. 199 to 203 Westminster Bridge Road and A302 Westminster Bridge Road;
 - (3) entering, exiting, stopping or proceeding on the Kennington Road northbound bus lane between its junctions with Cosser Street and Hercules Road;
 - (4) entering, exiting or proceeding in a westerly direction on Westminster Bridge Road between its junction with St George's Road and Station Approach Road.

This Order will also allow pedal cycles to travel in both directions on Upper Marsh between its junctions with the access road to the rear of Nos. 199 to 203 Westminster Bridge Road and A302 Westminster Bridge Road.

The Order will be effective between 18th March 2024 and 22nd March 2024 every night from 12:01 AM to 05:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs for pedal cycles only via A3036 Westminster Bridge Road, Lambeth Palace Road, Royal Street and Upper Marsh or in reverse to normal route of travel. For all other traffic via York Road, IMAX roundabout, Waterloo Road, St George's Circus and Westminster Bridge Road to normal route of travel. For northbound traffic on Kennington Road via Baylis Road to the diversion route above.
