(2) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via Edward Street, Sanford Street, Trundleys Road, Grinstead Road, Evelyn Street, Abinger Grove and Arklow Road, and vice versa.
- Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- The Order comes into force on the 26th May 2024 to remain in force for up to 2 months. (Note: Works are proposed to be carried out on 26th May 2024).
 The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
