Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham (Senegal Road Footpath, SE16) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic.) Order 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic Order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the Order are indicated below.

(1) Footpath closure in Senegal Road Footpath, SE16 in the section
of footpath that runs between the northern end of Senegal Road and
the eastern end of Silwood Street. (2) The diversion routes for pedestrian
traffic affected by the prohibition are via the east west section of
the Senegal Road footpath, which runs between Senegal Road and
Bolina Road, Bolina Road, and Silwood Street, and vice versa.

 Exemption is provided in the Order for persons and vehicles engaged on the works, being engaged in ambulance, fire brigade or police emergencies and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

 The Order comes into force on the 22nd April 2024 to remain in force for up to 2 months. (Note: Works are planned for the 22nd to 26th April 2024, but additional duration is given for contingencies).

4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway. Dated 12th April 2024.
