ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3 GLA ROAD (BOROUGH HIGH STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND BANNED TURNS) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable bridge inspection works to take place at A3 Borough High Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle;
 - (1) except pedal cycles from proceeding in a south-easterly direction on the A3 Borough High Street between its junctions with Railway Approach and St. Thomas Street;
 - (2) from turning right into Borough High Street from London Bridge Street;
 - (3) from turning left into Borough High Street from London Bridge Street.

The Order will also close the Western footway on Borough High Street from its junction with London Bridge Street and Bedale Street.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 8th April 2024 and 11th April 2024 every night 12:01 AM to 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via (westbound traffic on Tooley Street and non HGVs on Eastcheap join the diversion at Cannon Street), London Bridge, King William Street, Cannon Street, Queen Victoria Street, Blackfriars Bridge and Southwark Street to normal route of travel, (for eastbound traffic on Cannon Street not exceeding 18 tonnes mgw on) Eastcheap, Great Tower Street, Byward Street, Tower Hill, Minories, Goodmans Yard, Mansell Street, Tower Bridge Approach, Tower Bridge, Tower Bridge Road, Great Dover Street and Borough High Street to normal route of travel. (HGVs on Eastcheap and Cannon Street , King William Street, Monument Street, Fish Street Hill, Lower Thames Street, Upper Thames Street, Queen Street Place, Southwark Bridge and Southwark Street to normal route of travel.
