ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (BRIGHTON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gas main repair works to take place on the A23 Brighton Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping in the
 - 1) Parking and Disabled Persons' Vehicles Bays outside Nos. 110 to 116 Brighton Road and outside Nos.106 to 108 Brighton Road;
 - 2) Electric Vehicle Charging Bay outside Nos. 108 to 110 Brighton Road;
 - 3) Loading and Unloading Only Bays on outside of No.100 Brighton Road and Nos.120 to 122 Brighton Road.

The Order will be effective between 12:01 AM on 27th April 2024 until 7:00 PM on 24th May 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
