THE GLA ROADS (LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (BUS PRIORITY) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2009 A23 GLA ROAD (BRIGHTON ROAD) VARIATION ORDER 2024

THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (CROYDON) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 A23 GLA ROAD (BRIGHTON ROAD) VARIATION ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that on 2nd April 2024 it made the above named Orders, under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into force on 10th April 2024.
2. The general nature and effect of the Orders will be to:
 - a) extend the existing north-eastbound bus lane on the A23 Brighton Road between No.30 Brighton Road and Purley Knoll to start from No.68 Brighton Road, operating 'At Any Time', allowing Buses, Dial-a-Ride Buses, Pedal Cycles, Taxis and Solo Motorcycles;
 - b) replace existing single red lines with double red lines, operating 'No Stopping at Any Time' on Brighton Road south-eastern side between a point 26 metres north of No.31 Brighton Road and No.39 Brighton Road.
3. The roads which would be affected by the Orders is the A23 GLA Road – Brighton Road in the London Borough of Croydon.
4. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
