ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (CRUCIFIX LANE/DRUID STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable bridge inspection works to take place A200 Crucifix Lane.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit;
 - (1) any vehicle from entering, exiting, proceeding and stopping on Crucifix Lane/Druid Street between its junctions with Barnham Street and White Grounds;
 - (2) any pedestrians from proceeding on either footway on Crucifix Lane between its junctions with Barnham Street and White Grounds.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 10.00 PM on the 18th April 2024 until 6.00 AM on the 19th April 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs vehicles via Tower Bridge Road, Great Dover Street, Borough High Street, Tooley Street, Barnham Street to normal route of travel. for pedestrians via Barnham Street, Tooley Street, Tower Bridge Road to normal route of travel.
