ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A5 GLA ROAD (EDGWARE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND BANNED TURNS) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water connection works to take place A5 Edgware Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle:
 - (1) from stopping in the loading, unloading and Disabled persons vehicle bay on Seymour Street Opposite No.60 Seymour Street;
 - (2) from stopping in the loading, unloading and Disabled persons vehicle bay on Seymour Street Opposite No. 82 Seymour Street;
 - (3) travelling north-eastwards on Edgware Road from turning left into Seymour Street;
 - (4) travelling south-westwards on Edgware Road from turning right into Seymour Street;
 - (5) from turning right into Edgware Road from the eastern arm of Seymour Street.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 4th May 2024 and 12th May 2024 on the following days: Saturday, Sunday 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Seymour Street, Great Cumberland Place, Upper Berkeley Street, Connaught Street, Connaught Square to normal route of travel.
