Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Edward Street, SE8)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Network Rail works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** Road closure and no parking/waiting in Edward Street, SE8, between Amersham Grove and Milton Court Road. (2) Various diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibition shall be signed via local adjacent roads and New Cross Road, Deptford Church Street and Greenwich.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 3.** The Order comes into force on the 28th August 2024 to remain in force for up to 2 months. (Note: Works are proposed for 28th & 29th August 2024, but additional duration is given for contingency).
- 4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
