**ECCLESIASTICAL EXEMPTION (LISTED BUILDINGS
AND CONSERVATION AREAS) ORDER 1994**

TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to the procedures of the Baptist Union of Great Britain and the Baptist Union of Wales for the purposes of the above named Order Rye Lane Baptist Chapel, Peckham has applied to the Listed Buildings Advisory Committee for a Certificate of Authorisation to carry out the following works to their premises: Construction of an external ramp, moving steps forward to make this possible. Welcome area with toilet and coffee bar. Remodel the front stage area to create a central area for the band/worship team. Renew/replace electrics. New lighting including a gantry with spots. Lagging in roof and secondary double glazing. New boiler and hybrid system with radiators. Upwards extension of gallery rail. Remodel access to roof to enable access from main hall flat roof.

The Church building is listed Grade II and is in a Conservation Area.
