## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## THE A298 GLA ROAD (BUSHEY ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF MERTON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable investigation works to take place on A298 Bushey Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting or proceeding on a north-easterly direction on the A298 Bushey Road between its junctions with the northbound carriageway of Beverley Way and the service road fronting Nos. 80-88 Bushey Road. The Order will be effective at certain times between 3rd June 2024 and 29th December 2024 every night 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via A3 Beverley Way northbound, Coombe Lane West, Coombe Lane Flyover, Coombe Lane, Lambton Road, Worpole Road, Pepys Road, Approach Road and Grand Drive to normal route of travel.
