ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3220 GLA ROAD (EARLS COURT ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2024

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable crane works to take place on the A3220 Earls Court Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning left from A3220 Earls Court Road onto Old Brompton Road. The Order will be effective at certain times from 25th May 2024 until 10th June 2024, every Saturday at 7:00 AM to Monday at 7:00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as
- shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Redcliffe Gardens, Fulham Road, Finborough Road, Old Brompton Road to normal route of travel.
