## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A5 GLA ROAD (EDGWARE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2024

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Carriageway improvement works to take place at A5 Edgware Road.3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning right
- into the southern arm of Harrow Road from Edgware Road.

  The Order will be effective at certain times from 12.00 AM on the 18th May 2024 until 7.00 PM on the 1st October 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - Marshalls will be available to assist pedestrians.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
     anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
  - constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Edgware Road, Marble Arch, Edgware Road, Harrow Road to normal route of travel.
