ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3220 GLA ROAD (HOLLAND ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable structural survey works to take place on the A3220 Holland Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or exiting Holland Road at its junction with Russell Gardens.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 10:00 PM on 21st May 2024 to 5:00 AM on 22nd May 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Holland Road (Southeast Bound), Fairfax Place, Russell Road and reverse to normal route of travel
