

# Transport for London Notice

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### THE A2 GLA ROAD (NEW CROSS ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable pipe repair works to take place at A2 New Cross Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from
  - (1) stopping on the southern Kerb line of New Cross Road between its junctions with Nettleton Road and Pepys Road;
  - (2) entering Pepys Road and Queen's Road at their junctions with the A2 New Cross Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 10.00 PM on the 17th May 2024 until 5.00 AM on the 18th May 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs Via New Cross Road, Old Kent Road, New Kent Road, Elephant and Castle, Newington Butts, Kennington Park Road, Brixton Road, Camberwell New Road, Camberwell Church Street, Peckham Road, Lausanne Road, Gellatly Road, Drakefell Road, Shardeloes Road, Vesta Road, Pepys Road to normal route of travel.
