ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (NEW CROSS ROAD LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND SUSPENSION OF BUS LANE) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lewisham hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable sewer refurbishment works to take place at A2 New Cross Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on New Cross Road between its junctions with Hatcham Park Road and Briant Street.
 - All vehicles may use all bus lanes on New Cross Road between its junctions with Hatcham Park Road and Avonley Road.
 - The Order will be effective at certain times from 7:00 AM on the 13th May 2024 until 7:00 PM on the 30th May 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
