ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3 GLA ROAD (BOROUGH HIGH STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable rail bridge inspection works to take place on A3 Borough High Street.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle, except pedal cycles, from proceeding in a southerly direction on Borough High Street between its junctions with Station Approach and St Thomas Street. Access will be maintained on London Bridge between Eastcheap and Tooley Street /Station Approach/ Duke Street Hill. The Order will be effective at certain times between 25th June 2024 and 25th July 2024 every night from: 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via for traffic on Eastcheap and southbound traffic on Gracechurch Street: King William Street, Cannon Street, Queen Victoria Street, Blackfriars Bridge and Southwark Street to normal route of traffic, for traffic on Cannon Street (except vehicles over 18 tonnes m.g.w.) Eastcheap, Great Tower Street, Byward Street, Tower Hill, East Smithfield, Tower Bridge Approach, Tower Bridge Tower Bridge Road, Bricklayer's Arms, Great Dover Street and Borough High Street to normal route of travel, for vehicles over 18 tonnes m.g.w. King William Street, Monument Street Fish Street Hill, Lower Thames Street, Upper Thames Street, Queen Street Hill, Southwark Bridge, Southwark Bridge Road and Southwark Street to normal route of travel. for traffic on Tooley Street London Bridge and King William Street to the diversion route for Cannon Street above, vehicles over 18 tonnes m.g.w are to follow the diversion route for Eastcheap above.
