

## LICENSING ACT 2003

### APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF PREMISES LICENCE

Notice is hereby given that THIS IS CLAPHAM has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth for the grant of a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises: A section of Carriageway from the junction of Clapham High Street up to and including the section in front of Tsunami and Dr Espresso. which would authorise the following licensable activities: As part of car free road closure weekends during the summer, THIS IS CLAPHAM seeks permission to place additional tables and chairs in the carriageway and deliver a series of actives and entertainment, which could include: Live music, Recorded Music, Performances of Dance, Exhibition of films, Free activities.

The program is free to all and family friendly.

The entertainment program will be limited to Saturdays between 12:00 and 20:00hrs every weekend in July/August/September/October 2024.

The record of this application may be inspected during normal office hours by an appointment at the Licensing Section, 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG, or via the licensing authority's website, at [www.lambeth.gov.uk/licensing](http://www.lambeth.gov.uk/licensing).

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to

[licensing@lambeth.gov.uk](mailto:licensing@lambeth.gov.uk) and must be received no later than 23rd July 2024.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
