ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A202 GLA ROAD (VAUXHALL BRIDGE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- I. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable telecom works to take place at A202 Vauxhall Bridge Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle except pedal cycles from:
 - (1) entering in a westerly direction on Warwick Way between its junctions with Vauxhall Bridge Road and Upper Tachbook Street;
 - (2) stopping on the south-eastern side of Warwick Way between its junctions with Vauxhall Bridge Road and Upper Tachbook Street The Order will be effective between 29th July 2024 and 2nd August 2024 every night 8.00 PM to 5.00 AM or when those works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs vehicles via Vauxhall Bridge Road, Neathhouse Place, Wilton Road and Warwick Way to normal route of travel.
