Coming into force 30th July 2024

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Ia, and of all other enabling

powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on:

- I. This Order may be cited as The A3200 And A301 GLA Road Waterloo Bridge and Waterloo Roundabout, City of Westminster and London Borough of Lambeth) (Restriction of Traffic In Connection with Filming
- Borough of Lambeth) (Restriction of Traffic In Connection with Filming) Notice 2024, and shall come into force on the 30th July 2024.

 2. From 11:00 PM on 30th July 2024 until 4:30 AM on 31st July 2024 or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner,

subject to the provisions of article 4 below, no person shall cause or

- (I) A301 Waterloo Bridge/Lancaster Place and A3200 Waterloo Roundabout/Waterloo Road between its junctions with Strand and Tenison Way:
- (2) A3200 York Road between its junctions with Mepham Street and Waterloo Roundabout:
- (3) A3200 Stamford Street between its junctions with Cornwall Road and Waterloo Roundabout.
- During this period temporary holds will occur for short durations at these locations.

 3. (1) The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only during such times
 - signs.
 (2) The provisions specified in article 3 above shall not apply in respect

and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic

- of:
 (i) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works;
 - (i) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works;(ii) any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire
- brigade,
 ambulance or police purposes if the observance of those
 - provisions would hinder the use of the vehicle;
 (iii) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for
- London.

 4. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be
- indicated by traffic signs.
