ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROAD (THURLOW PARK ROAD AND SIDE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- I. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it has made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable a water defect repair works to take place at the A205 Thurlow Park Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
- proceeding in a westerly direction on the A205 Thurlow Park Road between its junctions with Croxted Road and the extended common boundary of Nos. 110 and 112 Thurlow Park Road;
 - boundary of Nos. 110 and 112 Thurlow Park Road;

 (2) entering or exiting Carson Road at its junction with Thurlow Park Road:
 - Road and the extended common boundary of Nos. 110 and 112 Thurlow Park Road.

 The Order will be effective between 10:00 PM on 28th July 2024 until 5:00 AM on 29th July 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such

times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by

(3) stopping on Thurlow Park Road between its junction with Croxted

- traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:(I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire
 - brigade, ambulance or police purposes;

 (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for
- London.

 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs for local traffic via Croxted Road and Norwood Road to normal route of travel. Or via South Croxted Road, Park Hall Road and Rosendale Road to the normal route of travel. For HGV's via
- Road and Rosendale Road to the normal route of travel. For HGV's via South Croxted Road, Dulwich Wood Park, College Road, Crystal Palace Parade, Church Road, Beulah Hill, Knights Hill and Norwood Road to normal route of travel.
