ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROAD (CAVENDISH ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames water works to take place on the A205 Cavendish Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on the A205 Cavendish Road between its junction with Klea Avenue and the extended common boundary of Nos. 23 and 25 Cavendish Road. The Order will be effective between 7:00 AM on 23rd July 2024 until 7:00 PM on 7th August 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
