 I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gas mains diversion works to take place at A2213 Kidbrooke Park Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting, stopping or proceeding in a southerly direction on Kidbrooke Park Road between its junctions with Eltham Road and Weigall Road. Local access will be maintained.
 The Order will be effective at certain times from 8.00 AM on the 22nd July 2024 until 7.00 PM on the 6th August 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be
- indicated by traffic signs.4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police.
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Kidbrooke Park Road, Sun in the Sands roundabout, Westhorne Avenue, Yorkshire Grey, Eltham Road to normal route of travel.
