

# Transport for London Notice

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### THE A3213 GLA ROAD (BELGRAVE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2.  
The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable district water exchange works to take place at A3213 Belgrave Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
  - (1) proceeding directly onto Eccleston Bridge from Belgrave Road;
  - (2) proceed in a northerly direction on Hugh Street between its junction with Belgrave Road and the common boundary of No.2 and No.4 Royal Belgrave House, Hugh Road;
  - (3) stop in the Parking bay outside Nos. 1 to 5 Blue Cross (Animal Hospital) Hugh Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 9.30 AM on the 21st August 2024 until 5.00 PM on the 27th August 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Hugh Street, St George's Drive, Eccleston Square, Belgrave Road, Gillingham Street, Wilton Road and Bridge Place to normal route of travel.
