THE A3220 GLA ROAD (EDITH GROVE, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable resurfacing works to take place at $\,$ A3220 Edith Grove.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting or proceeding on Edith Grove between its junction with Fulham Road and the extended common boundary of No. 4 and The Studio, Edith Grove.

The Order will be effective between 29th August 2024 and 2nd September 2024, every night from 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Fulham Road, Fernshaw Road, Edith Terrace to normal route of travel.
