## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## THE A5 GLA ROAD (EDGWARE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
   The purpose of the Order is to enable water works to take place at
- A5 Edgware Road

  3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting or proceeding in a south-easterly direction on Edgware Road between its junctions with the Southern Slip Road off Marylebone Fly

Over/Harrow Road and Chapel Street.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 12.01AM on the 27th August 2024 until 11.59pm on the 1st September 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Northern Slip Road off Marylebone Fly Over, Marylebone Fly Over, Marylebone Road, Albany Street, Osnaburgh Terrace, Osnaburgh Street, Great Portland Street, Marylebone Road and Old Marylebone Road to normal route of travel.
