ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3220 GLA ROAD (HOLLAND ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable resurfacing works to take place on the A3220 Holland Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:(1) Stopping on Holland Road between its junctions with Fairfax Place
 - and Holland Gardens;
 (2) entering, exiting or proceeding on the A3220 Holland Road between its junctions with Kensington High Street and Holland

Gardens Residential and Business access only will be maintained. The Order will be effective at certain times from 29th August 2024 until 5th September 2024, every night from 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Hammersmith Road, A219 Butterwick, Queen Caroline Street, Shepherd's Bush Road, Shepherd's Bush Green, Uxbridge Road, Holland Park Roundabout, Holland Road to normal route of travel.
