- ORDER 2024
 Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The
- effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.

 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable carriageway improvement works to take place at A20 Sidcup By-Pass Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 (I) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Sidcup By-Pass Road between its junctions with the unnamed on Slip Road connecting
 - Sidcup By-Pass Road to the circularly traffic system connecting Chislehurst Road and Perry Street and the administrative boundary of the London Borough of Bexley and Kent County Council;

 (2) enter the south-eastern carriageway of Sidcup By-Pass at its
 - (2) enter the south-eastern carriageway of Sidcup By-Pass at its junction with the unnamed on slip road connecting Edgington Way with the south-eastern carriageway of Sidcup By-Pass Road;
 (3) enter the north-western carriageway of Sidcup By-Pass Road at its
 - (3) enter the north-western carriageway of Sidcup By-Pass Road at its junction with the unnamed on slip road connecting Maidstone Road with the north-western carriageway of Sidcup By-Pass Road. The Order will be effective at certain times from 10.00 PM on 23rd August 2024 until 5.00 AM on 22nd February 2025 or when the works
 - time be indicated by traffic signs.

 Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be

indicated by traffic signs via for vehicles travelling in a South westerly direction via Sidcup Road, Westhorne Avenue, Yorkshire Grey Roundabout, South Circular Road/ Westhorne Avenue, East Rochester Way, M25, East Rochester Way, M25, Dareth Interchange and M25 to normal route of Travel. for traffic not wishing to use the motorway, via Sidcup Road, South Circular Road/ Westhorne Avenue, Yorkshire Grey Roundabout, Westhorne Avenue, East Rochester Way Slip Road, East Rochester Way, Dareth Interchange, Princes Road, Lowfield Street, Hawley Road, Church Hill, Main Road and London Road to normal route of travel. for traffic traveling in a south eastern direction via Frogal Corner roundabout, Sidcup- By-Pass and Westhorne Avenue to normal route of travel. for vehicles traveling travelling in a westerly direction via the M20, East Rochester Way, M25, East Rochester Way, South Circular Road, Shooters Hill, South Circular Road and Westhorne Avenue to normal route of travel. for traffic not wishing to use the Motorway via London Road, Swanley Interchange, London Road, Dartford Road, Princes Road, Princes Road interchange, Darenth Interchange and East Rochester Way slip Road to normal route of travel. for traffic travelling

in a north westerly direction via Maidstone Road and Eddington Way to

normal route of travel.
