## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## THE A23 GLA SIDE ROAD (WILLETT ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- I. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Croydon hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable a new water connection works to take place on Willett Place.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping in Willett Road from its junction with the A23 London Road in its entirety.

The Order will be effective between 7th September 2024 and 22nd September 2024 on the following days: Saturday, Sunday 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
