

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

The Lewisham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Consolidation) (Amendment No.3) Order 2024 **The Lewisham (Charged for Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2024**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council on 5 September 2024 made the above Traffic Regulation Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended). The Orders will come into force on 7 September 2024.

1. **PTO 1049** - The effect of the Order is as follows:
 - a) SYDENHAM ROAD - Replace single yellow line on south side between Nos 104 and 118 with double yellow lines and no loading at any time.
 - b) MAYOW ROAD -
 - i) Remove Car Club Bay on the East Side opposite the entrance to Earlsthorpe Road and relocate on the east side outside Mayow Road Hall;
 - ii) Extend the double yellow line and no loading at any time on the east side from the bus stop to Mayow Road Hall including the entrance to the garage.
 - c) WELLS PARK ROAD - reduce the length of double yellow lines on the southwest side, northwest of the junction with Exeter Place by 12 metres.

3. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
