Any representations against the application must be made in writing and received by the Licensing Team at the above address, by no later than later than 28th November 2024. Representations must be relevant and can only be on the licensing objectives of the prevention or crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance, and the protection of children from harm. Copies of all representations will be sent to the Applicant.
