Application for a Variation of a Premises Licence

An application has been made by Patrick Cadell for a variation to the premises licence at The Tin Shed, 33 All Saints Road London W11 1HE. The application is for the addition of Off-Licence Mon to Fri from 10.00 to 24.00, Sat 11.00 to 24.00 and Sun 12.00 to 23.30. And removal of condition 9 requiring alcohol to be only served as ancillary to a meal.

Any person wishing to submit comments to our application must give notice in writing to Licensing Authority address shown above, giving in detail the grounds of objection by 13th December 2024.

It is an offence under Section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003 for anyone to reckless or knowingly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application. The maximum fine on conviction is unlimited.
