THE A20 GLA ROAD (SIDCUP BY-PASS ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING)

ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable traffic signage works to take place at A20 Sidcup By-Pass Road.
 The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering,
- western carriageway of Sidcup By-Pass Road with the northern carriageway of Sevenoaks Way.

 The Order will be effective between 25th November 2024 and 24th May 2025 every night from 10.00 PM until 5.00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:

time be indicated by traffic signs.

- (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Crittalls Corner Roundabout, Edgington Way, Sidcup By-Pass Road and Swanley Interchange to normal route of travel.
