THE A200 GLA ROAD (CRUCIFIX LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable bridge inspection works to take place at A200 Crucifix Lane.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Bermondsey Street at its junctions with Crucifix Lane and Tooley Street;
 - (2) stopping on Crucifix Lane between its junctions with Barnham Street and Shand Street;
 - (3) stopping on Shand Street between its junctions with Tooley Street and Crucifix Lane local access to be maintained;

The Order will also allow two-way operation on Shand Street.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective every night from the 28th October 2024 until the 31st April 2025 between 10.00 PM and 5.00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via for traffic travelling Northbound on Bermondsey Street or Westbound on Crucifix Lane via Snowfields, Weston Street, Long Lane, Bermondsey Street, Tanner Street, Tower Bridge Road, Druid Street, Crucifix Lane, Barnham Street and Tooley Street or reverse to normal route of travel. For H.G.V.s via St Thomas Street, Borough High Street, Southwark Street, Southwark Bridge Road, Marshalsea Road, Borough High Street and Tooley Street to normal
