ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A202 GLA ROAD (VAUXHALL BRIDGE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable crane operational works to take place at A202 Vauxhall Bridge Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Vauxhall Bridge Road between its junctions with Victoria Street and Neathouse Place.

The Order will be effective from the 16th November 2024 until the 24th November 2024 every Saturday at 6.00 AM until Sunday at 8.00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Victoria Street, Buckingham Palace Road, St Georges Drive, Lupus Street and Bessborough Street to normal route of travel.
