ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A22 GLA ROAD (GODSTONE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable bridge repair works to take place on the A22 Godstone Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting, stopping or proceeding on the A22 Godstone Road between its junctions with Whytecliffe Road South and Foxley Hill Road.

 The Order will be effective between 11:00 PM on 23rd November 2024 until 4:00 AM on 25th November 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:

indicated by traffic signs.

- (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via A23 Brighton Road, London Road North, High Street Merstham, London Road South, London Road, Princess Way, A25 Redstone Hill, Nutfield Road, High Street Nutfield, Bletchingley Road, High Street Bletchingley, Godstone Road, High Street Godstone, Oxted Road, A22, Godstone Interchange, Godstone Hill, Caterham Bypass and Godstone Road to normal route of travel or the reverse.
