ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD AND SIDE ROAD (LONDON ROAD AND TYLECROFT ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable telephone kiosk upgrade works to take place on the A23 London Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons Vehicles Bay outside of Nos. 1353 1357 London Road:
 - (2) stopping in the Loading Bay outside of Nos. 1359 1361 London Road;
 - (3) stopping on Tylecroft Road both sides between its junction with the A23 London Road and the eastern extended building line of No. 1 Tylecroft Road.

The Order will be effective between 9:00 PM on 14th October 2024 until 5:00 AM on 15th October 2024 or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
