ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A302 GLA ROAD (VICTORIA STREET, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF BANNED TURN) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable telecom defect repair works to take place on the A302 Victoria Street.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning left from Allington Street into Victoria Street.
- The Order will be effective from 9.00 PM on the 4th November 2024 until 6.00 AM on the 5th November 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Victoria Street, Grosvenor Gardens, Lower Grosvenor Place and Bressenden Place or reverse to normal route of travel.
