## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3201 GLA ROAD (MARSHALSEA ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable resurfacing works to take place at A3201 Marshalsea Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on the north eastern kerb line on Marshalsea Road from its junction with Borough High Street to outside No. 7 Marshalsea Road.

The Order will be effective every night from the 21st October 2024 until the 20th January 2025 between 8.00 PM and 6.00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
