## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

THE A3220 GLA ROAD (BATTERSEA BRIDGE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING AND TEMPORARY BANNED TURNS) **ORDER 2024** 

- Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Wandsworth hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable bus lane improvement works to take place on A3220 Battersea Bridge Road.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit:
  - junctions with Hester Road and Battersea Park Road; (2) any vehicle from stopping in the Parking Bay on Colestown Street

any vehicle from stopping on Battersea Bridge Road between its

- at its junction with Battersea Bridge Road; (3)any vehicle from stopping in the Parking & Disabled Persons'
- Vehicle Bays outside Nos. I 9 Prince of Wales Drive; (4)any vehicle from turning left from Battersea Bridge Road into Westbridge Road;

any vehicle from entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping

- westbound on Parkgate Road between its junctions with Battersea Bridge Road and Radstock Street;
- (6) any vehicle from stopping on Battersea Church Road between its junctions with Battersea Bridge Road and Paveley Drive;
- (7)any vehicle from entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Hester Road between its junction with Battersea Bridge Road and the extended eastern building line of The Royal College of Art, Hester Road;
- (8)any vehicle from stopping on Beaufort Street at its junction with Cheyne Walk;
- HGVs from turning right from Battersea Bridge Road into Prince of Wales Drive;
- (10) any vehicle from turning left from Battersea Bridge Road into Surrey Lane.
- (11) any vehicle from stopping on Surrey Lane between its junctions with Battersea Bridge Road and Bridge Lane.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 8:00 AM on the 30th October 2024 until 6:00 PM on 28th February 2026 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2)anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be

indicated by traffic signs via Cheyne Walk, Cremorne Road, Kings Road, Wandsworth Bridge Road, York Road to normal route of travel.
