ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A5 GLA ROAD (EDGWARE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF BANNED TURNS) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable telecom works to take place at A5 Edgware Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (I) turning right into George Street from Edgware Road;
 - (2) turning right from Kendal Street into Edgware Road;
 - (3) turning right into Edgware Road from George Street;

The Order will be effective every night from the 5th November 2024 until the 7th November 2024 between 10.00 PM and 5.00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Sussex Gardens, Stanhope Terrace, Hyde Park Street and Bayswater Road to normal route of travel.
