## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

THE A200 GLA ROAD (JAMAICA ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice in consultation with the London Borough of Southwark that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable carriageway remedial works to take place at the A200 Jamaica Road.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from exiting Dockhead at its junction with Jamaica Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 10.00 PM on the 5th November 2024 until 5.00 AM on the 6th November 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Parker's Row, Wolseley Street and George Row to normal route of travel.
